

Fort Half Marathon Voc Tech Scholarship

Description

The Fort Half Marathon Voc Tech Scholarship is supported by the Fort Half Marathon Fund, a pass-through scholarship fund established at the Foundation in 2014 to assist graduating seniors at Fort Atkinson High School. The Fort Half Marathon Voc Tech Scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance for graduating seniors of Fort Atkinson High School who are planning to pursue a post-secondary education at a technical/vocational school in Wisconsin.

This scholarship is funded by proceeds raised from The Fort Atkinson Half Marathon and 5K hosted by the Fort Atkinson Chamber of Commerce. A committee of local supporters coordinates this annual event.

Full payment of the scholarship is made in one year (in two installments) and will be paid directly to the school the recipient attends.

Eligibility

Eligible students must meet all the following criteria:

- Are graduating seniors at Fort Atkinson High School.
- Must plan to attend and be accepted in a program at a recognized, accredited post-secondary technical or vocational school in Wisconsin.
- Must, at the time of application for the scholarship, have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Selection

Applicants will be reviewed by a committee composed of a representative of the Fort Atkinson Community Foundation, the Superintendent of the Fort Atkinson School District (or his/her designee), a teacher at Fort Atkinson High School, a member of the community recruited by the Community Foundation, and a member of the Fort Half Marathon Committee.

Selection will be based on the applicants' commitment to reaching their post-secondary goals and their plan for how to get there. The financial need of each applicant will be taken into consideration in determining the amount of the scholarship.
