

Fort Atkinson Community Foundation Scholarship Report 2015

In 2015, the Fort Atkinson Community Foundation awarded a record 93 scholarships to 73 students. Of those, 58 scholarships went to 47 high school seniors; 31 scholarships went to 22 undergraduate or graduate students; and 4 tech scholarships went to older tech students.
