

# **David F. Veith Performing Arts Scholarship**

## **Description**

The David F. Veith Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in memory of David Veith who was a teacher at Fort Atkinson High School. Born and raised in Waterloo, David's passion was teaching. He was a gentle and caring man and was devoted to seeking equality for all people. David loved the theater and had a big heart for those kids who didn't quite fit the mold or who were subjected to harassment.

The scholarship is available to graduating seniors at Fort Atkinson High School who intend to pursue a bachelor's degree in the performing arts.

Full payment of the scholarship is made in one year.

## **Eligibility**

Eligible students are graduating seniors of Fort Atkinson High School who intend to pursue a bachelor's degree at a four-year college majoring in a performing arts or related field.

## **Selection**

Applicants will be reviewed by a committee composed of a representative of the Fort Atkinson Community Foundation, the Superintendent of Schools (or his/her designee), two members of the community recruited by the scholarship chairman of the Fort Atkinson Community Foundation (one of whom may be a high school teacher), and a Veith estate designee, if available.

Selection will be based on the applicant's prospect of success in the performing arts fields and the content of an essay outlining the applicant's plans. Financial need will be considered though it is not required to apply.
