

Kathleen Grabil Thorndike Scholarship

Description

The Kathleen Grabil Thorndike Scholarship is funded by a bequest from the estate of E. J. and Elizabeth Thorndike of Monterey County, California, given in honor of Kathleen Grabil Thorndike.

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a graduating senior at Fort Atkinson High School who might otherwise not be able to pursue a college education due to financial hardship.

The award is paid over two years.

Eligibility

Eligible students are graduating seniors of Fort Atkinson High School who:

- Are planning to enroll in a four-year, degree-granting college or university or pursue a liberal arts transfer program at a vocational/technical college with the intention of transferring to a four-year degree granting university to earn a bachelor's degree.
- Have significant financial need.

Selection

All applications will be reviewed by a committee selected by the Pupil Services Department at the Fort Atkinson High School.

Selection will be based on the content of the application and the applicant's prospect of success in college. Financial need will be given very serious consideration.
